Service contracts, financial assistance agreements, and City facilities agreements must include this upward adjustment of wage rate employees on July 1 of each year. In addition, Contractor agrequire all of its subcontractors, sublessees, and concession subject to the LWO to comply with the LWO and all applicable and rules.  1.
