****	 9.2 A contract entered into with any contractor or subcontractor in violation of Labor Code section 1771.1(a) shall be subject to cancellation, provided that a contract for public work shall not be unlawful, void, or voidable solely due to the failure of the awarding body, contractor, or any subcontractor to comply with the requirement of section 1725.5 of this section. 9.3 By performing services detailed in this purchase order, Contract is certifying that he or she has verified that all subcontractors used on this public works project are registered with the DIR in complian with Labor Code sections 1771.1 and 1725.5, and Contractor shall proof of registration to the City upon request. B. Living Wages. This Contract is subject to the City's Living Wage Ordinance (LWO), codified at SDMC sections 22.4201 through 22.4200 requires payment of minimum hourly wage rates and other be unless an exemption applies. SDMC section 22.4225 requires each Contractor to fill out and file a living wage certification with the City Manager within thirty (30) days of Award of the Contract. LWO and health benefit rates are adjusted annually in accordance with S section 22.4220(b) to reflect the Consumer Price Index. Service contracts, financial assistance agreements, and City facilities agreements must include this upward adjustment of wage rates to employees on July 1 of each year. In addition, Contractor agrees to require all of its subcontractors, sublessees, and concessionaires subject to the LWO to comply with the LWO and all applicable reguland rules. 1. Exemption from Living Wage Ordinance. Pursuant to SDMC se 22.4215, this Contract may be exempt from the LWO. For a determ on this exemption, Contractor must complete the Living Wage Ordi Application for Exemption. C. Highest Wage Rate Applies.
