The Bidder shall not be required hire only registered subcontractors and is exempt from submittir list of all subcontractors that is required in section 11 above. (La Code section 1773.3). B. Living Wages. This Contract is subject to the City's Living Wa Ordinance (LWO), codified at SDMC sections 22.4201 through LWO requires payment of minimum hourly wage rates and othe unless an exemption applies. SDMC section 22.4225 requires e to fill out and file a living wage certification with the City Manage within thirty (30) days of Award of the Contract. LWO wage and benefit rates are adjusted annually in accordance with SDMC sec 22.4220(b) to reflect the Consumer Price Index. Service contract financial assistance agreements, and City facilities agreements include this upward adjustment of wage rates to covered employ July 1 of each year. In addition, Bidder agrees to require all of the subcontractors, sublessees, and concessionaires subject to the comply with the LWO and all applicable regulations and rules. 1.1. Exemption from Living Wage Ordinance. Pursuant to SDM 22.4215, this Contract may be exempt from the LWO. For a det on this exemption, Bidder must complete the Living Wage Ordin Application for Exemption. C. Highest Wage Rate Applies.
