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is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the DIR. A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or enter into any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter of the Labor Code unless currently registered and qualified to perform the work pursuant to Section 1725.5. In accordance with Labor Code section 1771.(a), "[i]t is not a violation of this section for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded." 9.1. A Contractor's inadvertent error in listing a subcontractor who is not registered pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 in a response to a solicitation shall not be grounds for filing a bid protest or grounds for considering the bid non-responsive provided that any of the following apply: (1) the subcontractor is registered prior to bid opening; (2) within twenty-four hours after the bid opening, the subcontractor is registered and has paid the penalty registration fee specified in Labor Code section 1725.5; or (3) the subcontractor is replaced by another registered contractor pursuant to Public Contract Code section 4107. 9.2. A Contract entered into with any Contractor or subcontractor in violation of Labor Code section 1771.1(a) shall be subject to c ancellation, provided that a Contract for public work shall not be unlawful, void, or voidable solely due to the failure of the awarding body, Contractor, or any subcontractor to comply with the requirements of section 1725.5 of this section. 9.3. By submitting a bid or proposal to the City, Contractor is certifying that he or she has verified that all subcontractors used on

this public works project are registered with the DIR in compliance with	
Labor Code sections 1771.1 and 1725.5, and Contractor shall provide proof of registration for themselves and all listed subcontractors to	
the City at the time of bid or proposal due date or upon request.	
10. Stop Order. For Contractor or its subcontractor(s) engaging in the	
performance of any public work contract without having been registered in violation of Labor Code sections 1725.5 or 1771.1, the Labor	
Commissioner shall issue and serve a stop order prohibiting the use of	
the unregistered Contractor or unregistered subcontractor(s) on ALL	
public works until the unregistered Contractor or unregistered subcontractor(s) is registered. Failure to observe a stop order is a	
misdemeanor.	
11. List of all Subcontractors. The City may ask Contractor for the most	
current list of subcontractors (regardless of tier), along with their DIR registration numbers, utilized on this contract at any time during	
performance of this contract, and Contractor shall provide the list	
within ten (10) working days of the City's request. Additionally,	
Contractor shall provide the City with a complete list of all subcontractors utilized on this contract (regardless of tier), within	
ten working days of the completion of the contract, along with their DIR	
registration numbers. The City shall withhold final payment to	
Contractor until at least 30 days after this information is provided to the City.	
12. Exemptions for Small Projects. There are limited exemptions for	
installation, alteration, demolition, or repair work done on projects of	
\$25,000 or less. The Contractor shall still comply with Labor Code sections 1720 et. seq. The only recognized exemptions are listed below:	
12.1. Registration. Contractor will not be required to register with the	
DIR for small projects. (Labor Code section 1771.1).	
12.2. Certified Payroll Records. The records required in Labor Code section 1776 shall be required to be kept and submitted to the City of	
San Diego, but will not be required to be submitted online with the DIR	
directly. Contractor will need to keep those records for at least three	
years following the completion of the contract. (Labor Code section	
1771.4). 12.3. List of all Subcontractors. Contractor shall not be required to	
hire only registered subcontractors and is exempt from submitting the

This Contract is subject to the City's Living Wage Ordinance (LWO), codified at SDMC sections 22.4201 through 22.424 LWO requires payment of minimum hourly wage rates and other bene unless an exemption applies. SDMC section 22.4225 requires each Contractor to fill out and file a living wage certification with the City Manager within thirty (30) days of Award of the Contract. LWO wa and health benefit rates are adjusted annually in accordance with SDM section 22.4220(b) to reflect the Consumer Price Index. Service contracts, financial assistance agreements, and City facilities agreements must include this upward adjustment of wage rates to covemployees on July 1 of each year. In addition, Contractor agrees to require all of its subcontractors, sublessees, and concessionaires subject to the LWO to comply with the LWO and all applicable regulation drules. 1.1. Exemption from Living Wage Ordinance. Pursuant to SDMC sect 22.4215, this Contract may be exempt from the LWO. For a determine on this exemption, Contractor must complete the Living Wage Ordinar Application for Exemption. C. Highest Wage Rate Applies.
