Failure to observe a stop order is a misdemeanor. 11. List of all Subcontractors. The City shall withhold final payment to Contractor until at least 30 days after this information is provided to the City. 12. Exemptions for Small Projects. There are limited exemptions for installation, alteration, demolliton, or repair work done on projects of \$25,000 or less. The Contractor will not be required to the City of San Diego, but will not be required to be kept and submitted online with the DIR for small projects. (Labor Code section 1776.1). 12. Certified Payroll Records. The records required in Labor Code section 1776 shall be required to be kept and submitted on the City of San Diego, but will not be required to be submitted online with the DIR for small projects. the the contract.
