The City shall withhold final payment to Contractor until at least 30 days after this information is provided to the City. 12. Exemptions for Small Projects. There are limited exemptions for installation, alteration, demolition, or repair work done on projects of \$25,000 or less. The Contractor shall still comply with Labor Code sections 1720 et. seq. The only recognized exemptions are listed belot 12.1. Registration. Contractor will not be required to register with the DIR for small projects. (Labor Code section 1771.1). 12.2. Certified Payroll Records. The records required in Labor Code section 1776 shall be required to be kept and submitted to the City of San Diego, but will not be required to be submitted online with the DI directly. Contractor will need to keep those records for at least three years following the completion of the contract. (Labor Code section 1771.4). 12.3. List of all Subcontractors. Contractor shall not be required to hire only registered subcontractors and is exempt from submitting the list of all subcontractors that is required in section 11 above. (Labor Code section 1773.3). B. Living Wages. This Contract is subject to the City's Living Wage Ordinance (LWO), codified at SDMC sections 22.4221 through 22.424 LWO requires payment of minimum hourly wage rates and other bene unless an exemption applies. SDMC section 22.4225 requires each Contractor to fill out and file a living wage certification with the City Manager within thirty (30) days of Award of the Contract. LWO wa and health benefit rates are adjusted annually in accordance with SDI section 22.4220(b) to reflect the Consumer Price Index. Service contracts, financial assistance agreements, and City facilities agreements must include this upward adjustment of wage rates to cov employees on July 1 of each year. In addition, Contractor agrees to require all of its subcontractors, sublessees, and concessionaires subject to the LWO to comply with the LWO and all appli	R 15.
