101. <u>Fiscal Year 2013 Regional Park Fund</u> Presenter: Jim Winter, Project Officer II, Asset Management, Park and Recreation Mr. Winter presented a report and PowerPoint presentation with the Park and Recreation Department's recommendation for allocating the Regional Park Improvement Funds for Fiscal Year 2013 and over a five (5) year period.

Board Members Comments and Questions:

- Mr. Bussell asked, in the event there are insufficient funds in future RPIF, what the alternate plan is if there are no available funds to complete projects. Mr. Winter responded by stating other funding sources will be explored such as grants and that no additional projects would be undertaken until the original projects are completed.
- Ms. Granowitz asked whether the proposed RPIF allocations are consistent with the Citywide Capital Improvements Program (CIP). Mr. Winter indicated that the recommended allocations are consistent with the needs of the various regional parks that are eligible for the funding. Ms. Granowitz suggested that the Golf Course Drive sidewalk could be considered for allocation, and Mr. Winter noted it is on the list of potential projects eligible for RPIF funding.

Mr. Chávez asked why there is a three-year gap between design and construction for the Chicano Park comfort station. Mr. Field explained that the design process typically takes several years and noted that other funds are being pursued to accelerate the project, including possible grants and local development impact fees.

A motion was made by Ms. Granowitz and seconded by Mr. Bussell to approve staff recommended allocations for Fiscal Year 2013 Regional Park Funds. The motion was approved unanimously (6-0).
