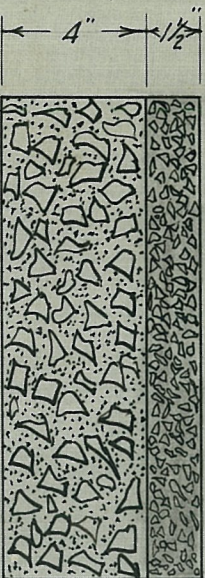




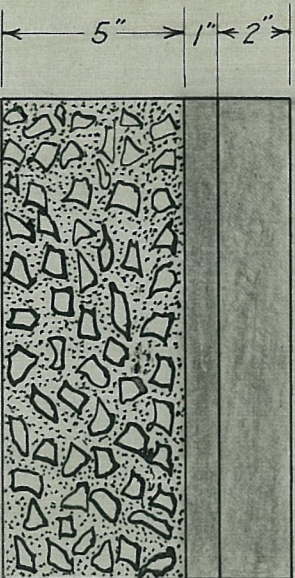
One-course Concrete Pavement 4" thick of 1:2:4 Concrete. Approximate cost - 10¢ per sq. Ft.



Pavement with 1:2:4 Concrete Base, and wearing surface of Asphaltic Oil and Broken Stone Screenings. Approximate cost - 11¢ per sq. Ft.



Pavement with 1:3:6 Concrete Base 4" thick, and wearing surface of Asphalt Macadam 1 1/2" thick, according to specifications in Ordinance No. 6747. Approximate cost - 14¢ Per sq. Ft.



Pavement with 1:3:6 Concrete Base 5" thick, and 1" Binder Course and Wearing Surface of Asphalt 2" thick, according to specifications in Ordinance No. 5176. Approximate cost 19¢ per sq. Ft.
