Failure to observe a stop order is a misdemeanor. 11. List of all Subcontractors. The City may ask Contractor for the mos current list of subcontractors (regardless of tier), along with their DIR registration numbers, utilized on this contract at any time during performance of this contract, and Contractor shall provide the list within ten (10) working days of the City's request.
