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	Commissioner shall issue and serve a stop order prohibiting the use of the unregistered Contractor or unregistered subcontractor(s) on ALL public works until the unregistered Contractor or unregistered subcontractor(s) is registered. Failure to observe a stop order is a misdemeanor.  11. List of all Subcontractors. The City may ask Contractor for the mo current list of subcontractors (regardless of tier), along with their DIR registration numbers, utilized on this contract at any time during performance of this contract, and Contractor shall provide the list within ten (10) working days of the City's request. Additionally, Contractor shall provide the City with a complete list of all subcontractors utilized on this contract (regardless of tier), within ten working days of the completion of the contract, along with their DI registration numbers. The City shall withhold final payment to Contractor until at least 30 days after this information is provided to the City.  12. Exemptions for Small Projects. There are limited exemptions for installation, alteration, demolition, or repair work done on projects of \$25,000 or less. The Contractor shall still comply with Labor Code sections 1720 et. seq. The only recognized exemptions are listed beld 2.1. Registration. Contractor will not be required to register with the DIR for small projects. (Labor Code section 1771.1).  12.2. Certified Payroll Records. The records required in Labor Code section 1776 shall be required to be kept and submitted to the City of San Diego, but will not be required to be submitted online with the DI directly. Contractor will need to keep those records for at least three years following the completion of the contract. (Labor Code section 1771.4).  12.3. List of all Subcontractors. Contractor shall not be required to hire only registered subcontractors and is exempt from submitting the list of all subcontractors that is required in section 11 above.
