Bidder agrees to require all of its subcontractors, sublessees, and concessionaires subject to the LWO to comply wit LWO and all applicable regulations and rules. 1. Payment of Living Wages. Pursuant to San Diego Municipal Cosection 22.4220(a), Bidder and its subcontractors shall ensure that workers who perform work under this Contract are paid not less thir required minimum hourly wage rates are available on the City web at https://www.sandiego.gov/purchasing/programs/livingwage/. Bid its subcontractors shall post a notice informing workers of their rigf at each job site or a site frequently accessed by covered employee prominent and accessible place in accordance with San Diego Mun Code section 22.4226(e). 1.2 LWO wage and health benefit rates are adjusted annually in accordance with San Diego Municipal Code section 22.4220(b) to the Consumer Price Index.
